PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Music Audition Requirements

Vocal: Student will have prepared and perform one piece of music with a CD accompaniment track or the sheet music.

Piano: Student will have prepared:
One solo in any genre.
Student will be asked to play three chromatically adjacent major scales.
Sight reading.

Woodwinds, Brass, and Strings:

Student will have prepared:
Three chromatically adjacent major scales.
One chromatic scale (2 octaves preferred).
One solo or etude (showing both musicality and technical ability).
Sight reading.

Percussion: Student will have prepared:
One solo or etude on either snare drum or a keyboard instrument.
Student will be asked to play three chromatically adjacent major scales and PAS rudiments.
Sight reading.

Awards Given range from \$500 - \$1,250 per semester.

Scholarship Requirements

Students are to be enrolled in classes as per Wallace State Scholarship requirements.

Students must be in assigned performing ensembles each semester and be a regular attending member of those ensembles.

Students must maintain a semester GPA of 2.5.

In addition to the above requirements, music majors must be in a private lesson with regular attendance.
