Theatre Audition Requirements

Acting:

Student will perform a prepared 1-2 minute monologue (classical or contemporary).
Student may be asked to cold read a monologue or scene.

Musical Theatre:

Student will perform a prepared selection from a musical (@32 measures).
Please bring an accompaniment track (can use a phone or CD).

Student will perform a prepared 1-2 minute monologue (classical or contemporary).
Student may be asked to cold read a monologue or scene.

Technical Theatre:

Student will bring a prepared portfolio of examples of their work in any of the following:

- Directing
- Stage Management
- Scenic or Props Design
- Costume Design
- Wigs/Hair/Makeup Design
- Lighting Design
- Sound Design

All students auditioning for a scholarship will have a brief interview/ talk with the theatre instructor and possibly other fine arts instructors.

Scholarship Requirements

Students are to be enrolled in classes as per Wallace State Scholarship requirements.
Students must maintain a semester GPA of 2.5.
Students must participate in all Wallace State Theatre Productions (1 per semester).
Students must enroll in the following classes:

Fall Semester 1: Theatre Workshop I (1hr credit)
 Acting I (3 hr credit)
 Theatre Appreciation (3 hr credit) – online or in person

Spring Semester 1: Theatre Workshop II (1 hr credit)
 Stagecraft or Musical Theatre I (3 hr credit)

Fall Semester 2: Theatre Workshop III (1 hr credit)
 Acting II (3 hr credit)

Spring Semester 2: Theatre Workshop IV (1 hr credit)
 Stagecraft or Musical Theatre II (3 hr credit)
